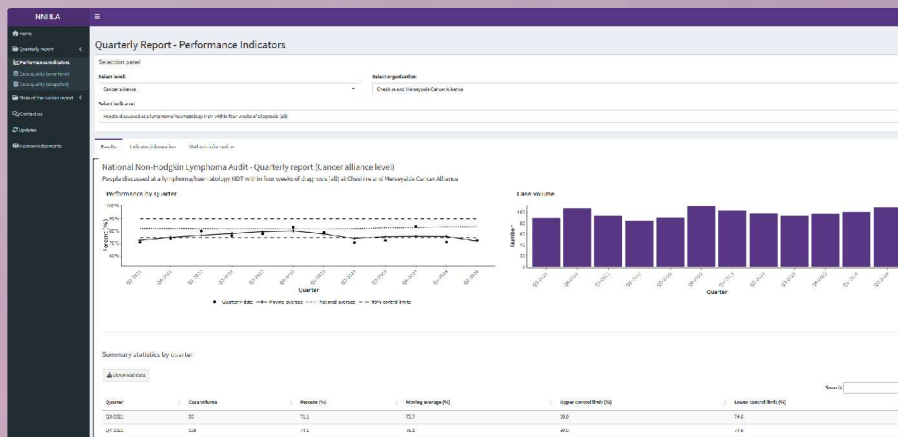

Data Dashboards for the NNHLA

The dashboards provide up to date information for NHS trusts in England on a quarterly basis on both the performance indicators and data quality measures.

The dashboards are updated annually with outcome of the Performance Indicators and Data Quality for England AND Wales.

The dashboards will undergo ongoing development, and we welcome feedback for future updates. Phase two, set for 2025, will involve broader consultation with stakeholders, including PPI representatives, to ensure the dashboards meet user needs.

We encourage all provider teams to review their data completeness and make improvements as required. This will increase the number of people diagnosed with NHL that we can include in analyses and increase the range of analyses we can conduct.
