NNHLA shares its second, Annual State of the Nation Report

On the 11th of September, the [NNHLA project team](#) was excited to share its second [Annual State of the Nation Report](#). This year's report includes people diagnosed with NHL from 1 January 2022 to 31 December 2022 in England, and 1 January 2023 to 31 December 2023 in Wales.

It reports on 8 out of the 11 performance indicators for England, and 5 out of the 11 performance indicators for Wales, which are outlined in the [NNHLA Quality Improvement Plan](#). The report provides results on a new accompanying contextualising measure regarding emergency presentations for those diagnosed with NHL in England from January 2021 to December 2022.

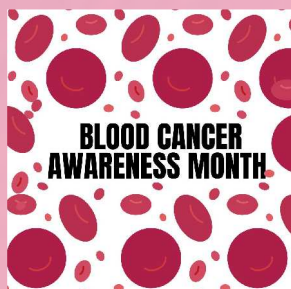
