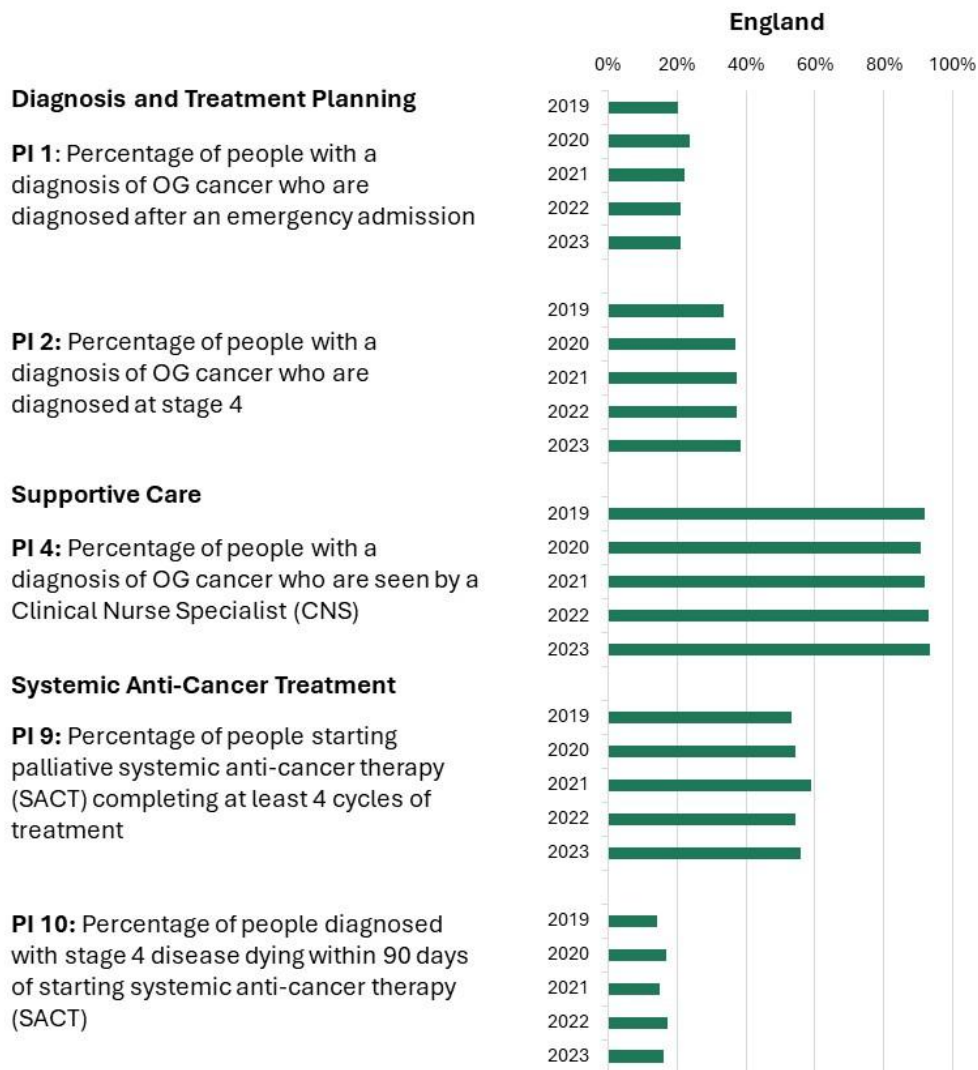

#### Supplementary Figure 1. Annual results by performance indicator, by year of diagnosis, England

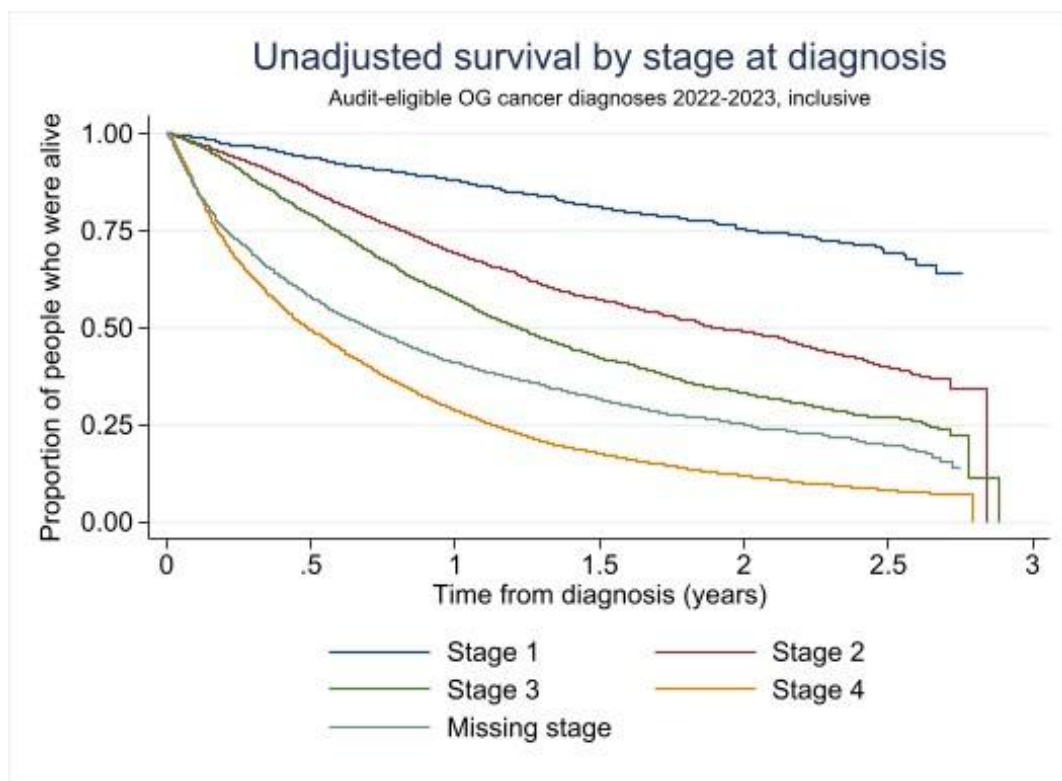

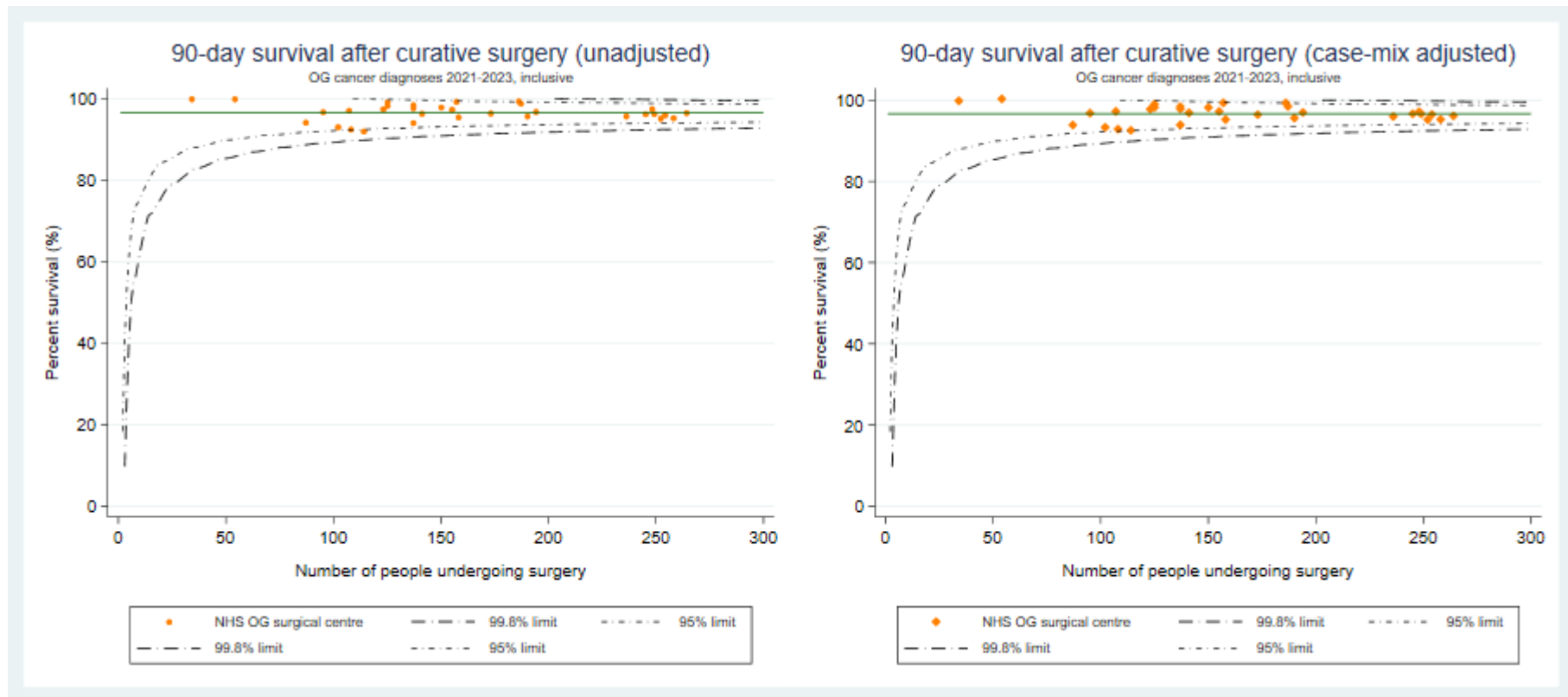
