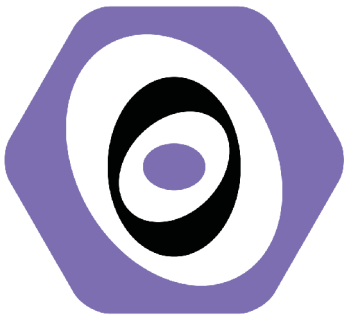

Latest update to data dashboard

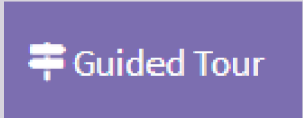
A further update to our interactive dashboards was published on the 9th of July. Access the dashboard [here](#).

The reporting periods for the dashboards: have been updated as follows:

- i. Performance indicators
 - diagnoses between 1 January 2023 and 31 December 2025
 - ii. Data quality (over time)
 - diagnoses between 1 January 2023 and 31 December 2025
 - iii. Data quality (snapshot)
 - diagnoses between 1 January 2024 and 31 December 2025
- Main data source: Rapid Cancer Registration Dataset

✧ A new feature in this latest release, is a "Guided Tour" button that walks through the key features of the dashboard.

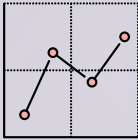
