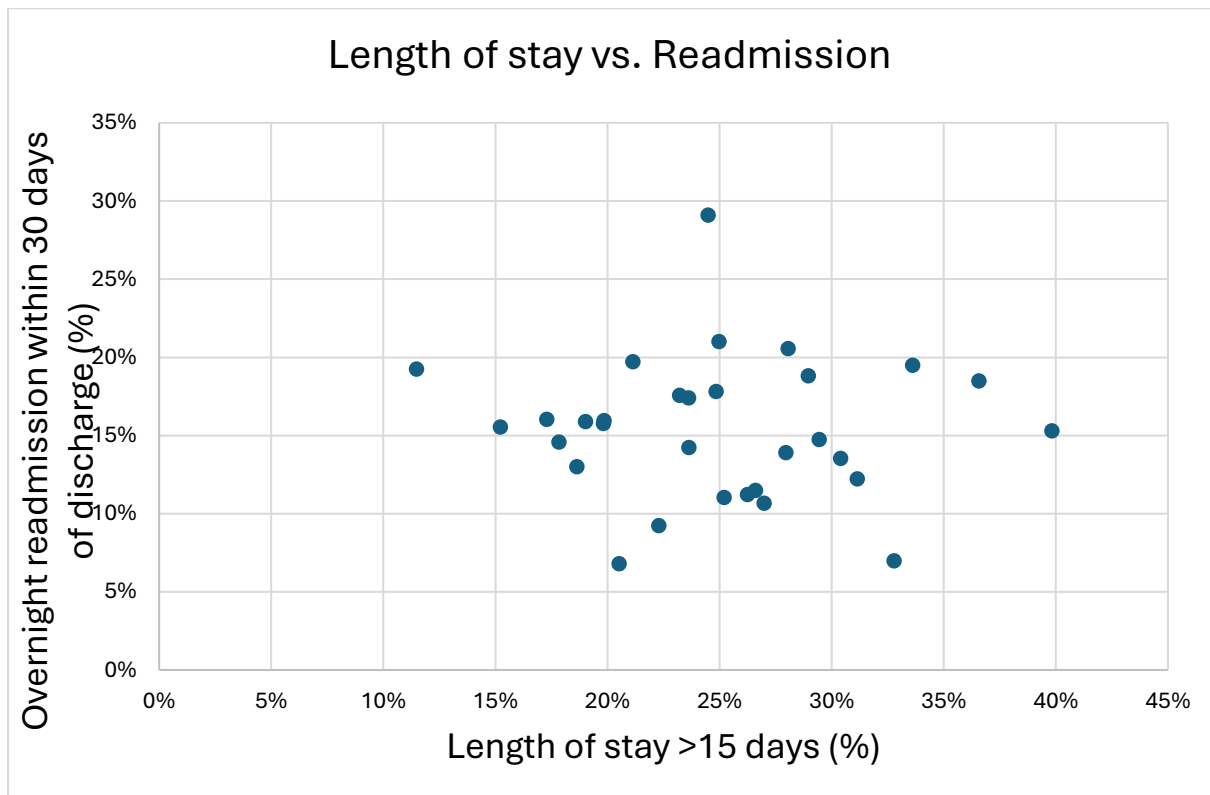

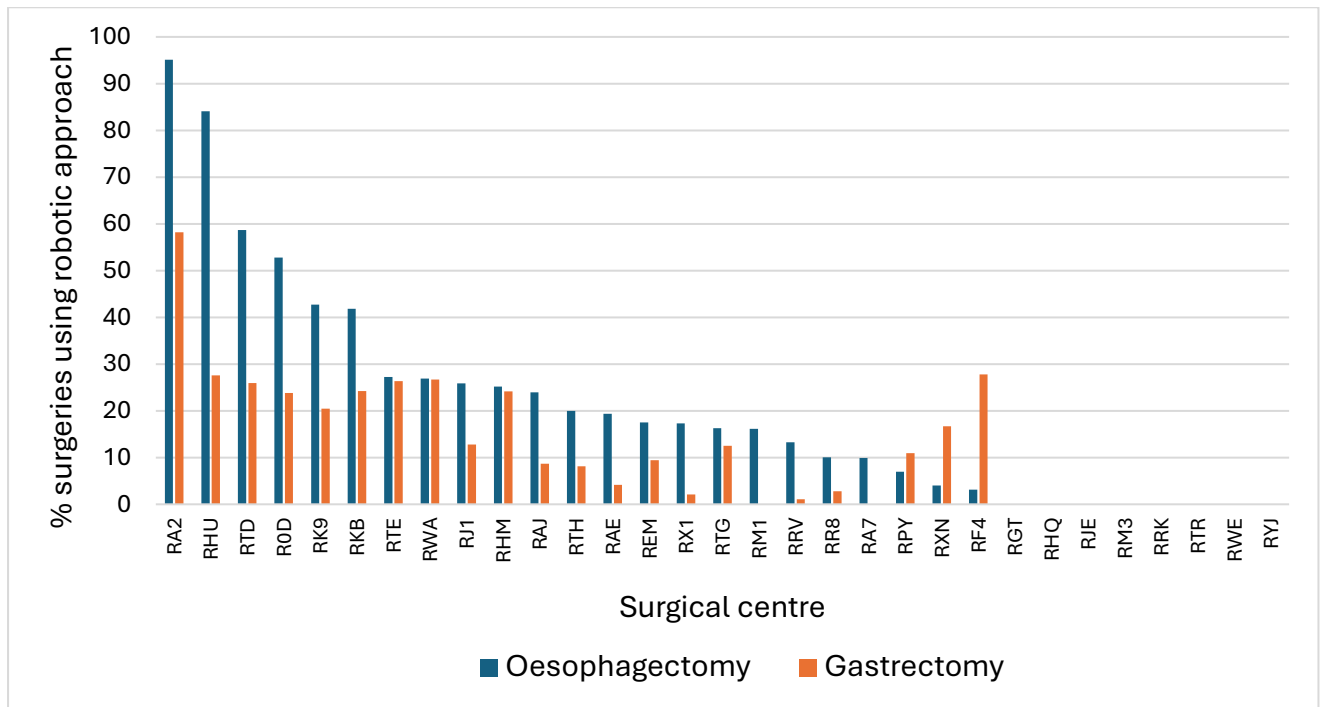
Supplementary Figure 1. Length of stay >15 days vs Readmission within 30-days following discharge by surgical centre, England
