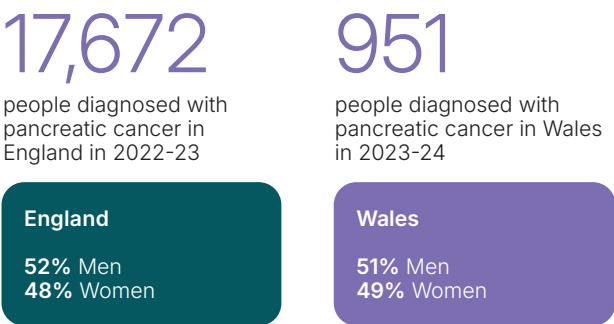


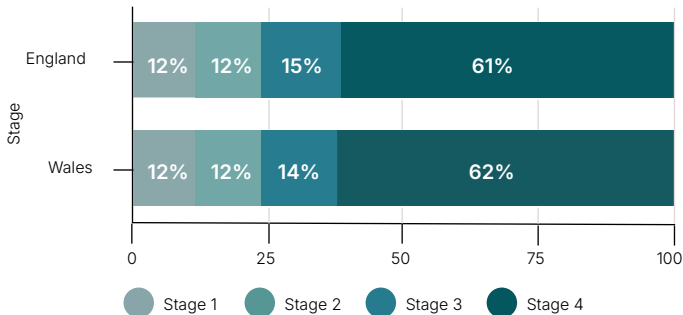

Stage at diagnosis*

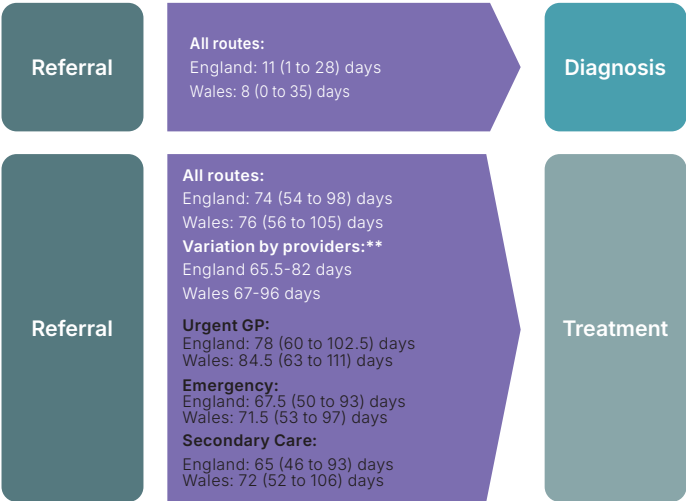

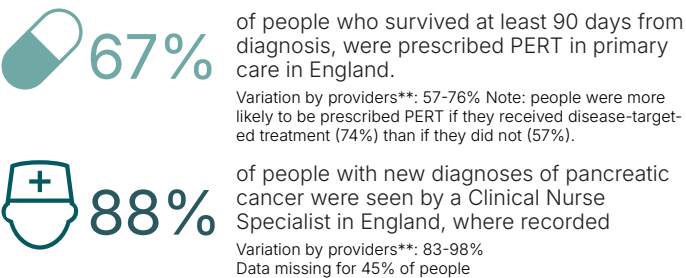


Median times along pathway (IQR ***)



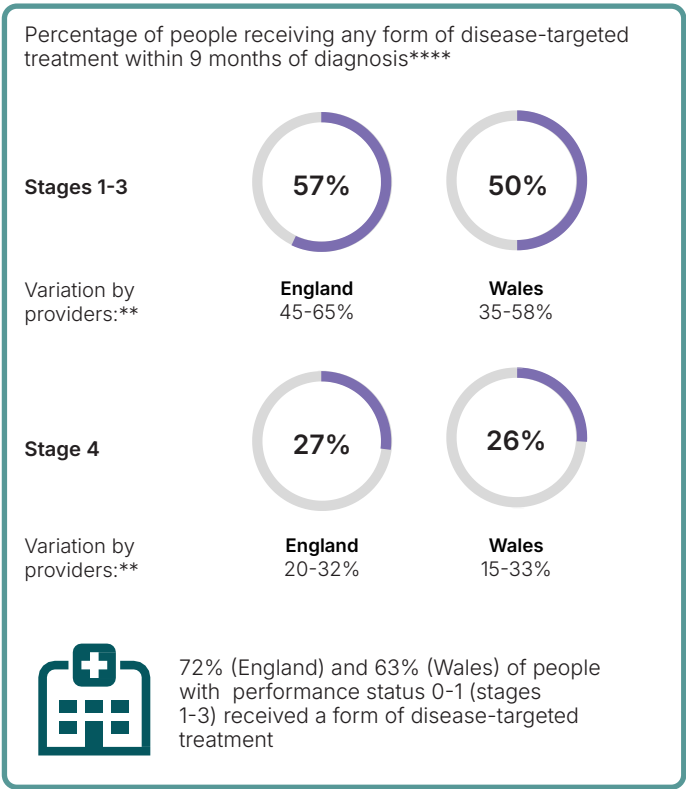
